


Terms of Use

jOpenSimPayPal Component



This component is distributed as a 3rd party extension by jOpenSim to be used with Joomla version 2.5.x

The jOpenSimPayPal component is provided as an add-on extension to jOpenSimMoney for which a license should be purchased from www.jopensim.com

Before installing this component please ensure all existing components, modules and plugins provided by jOpenSim are updated.

For use of this component the user must also hold a current paypal account.

Full details on how to install the jOpenSimPayPal component have also been provided and must be read before any installation is attempted.

The jOpenSimPayPal component is used at the users own risk and jOpenSim will not accept liability for any losses incurred when using for commercial use.

The component is intended to be used for transactions from real world currency to virtual currency and visa verse only.

The jOpenSimPayPal component does not record any security details of the users PayPal account. Therefore any discrepancies in paypal transactions need to be addressed directly to PayPal not jOpenSim.

Grid owners using the jOpenSimPayPal component are responsible for providing their own terms and conditions for users accessing the component.

Support from jOpenSim on the use of this component can be requested however this is not mandatory.

Although steps have been taking in the writing of this module to ensure security, it is ultimately the responsibility of the user.

jOpenSim will at times provide updates for the jOpenSimPayPal component but this is on an as and when required basis to fix bugs and provide user upgrades.
jOpenSim holds the right to change terms of use of this component.

Warning: Installing 3rd party extensions may compromise Joomla's security. Make sure that any 3rd party extensions you install are from a trusted distributor.
